The children thoroughly enjoyed 'Back to 1924' day and I hope you all managed to come into school to see all the hard work in each class and enjoyed our Archive Room.
- As you know, this is the **last day of this very short half term** and the children return to school on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> February (Monday is an INSET day). Next half term is also 5 weeks and ends on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> March.
- Due to the work we have completed on our Centenary celebrations, our **Eisteddfod** celebrations and competitions are going to be moved on a week.
